


# How-To: Connect to the Sage Guest Wifi Network

If you are a guest of the college and would like temporary wireless access this article is for you.

 You will need to provide your mobile phone number to verify your access.

## Here's how it's done

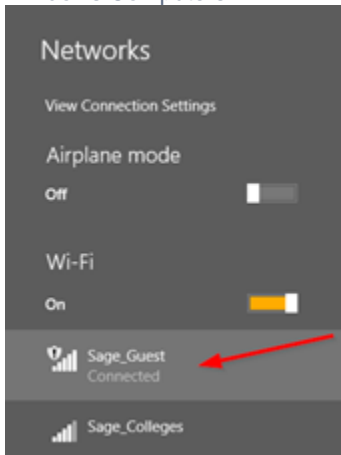
Connect to the "Sage\_Guest" Wifi Network on your Laptop, Tablet, or Cellphone.

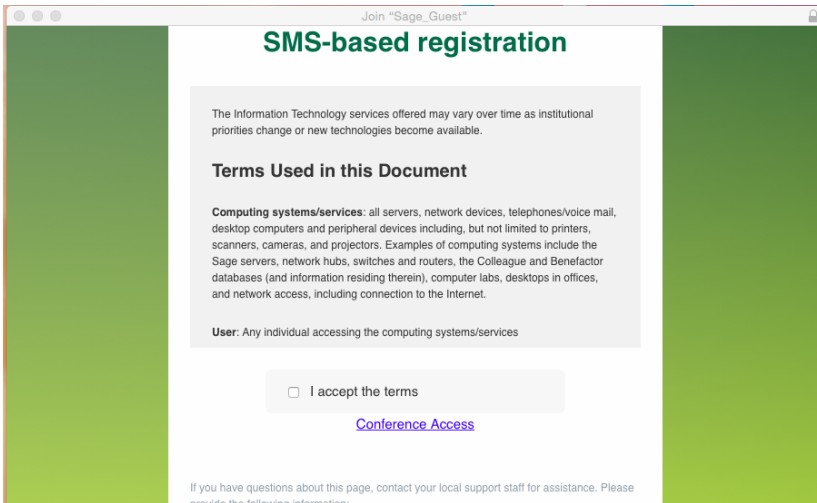
### Windows Computers

## Review the Terms

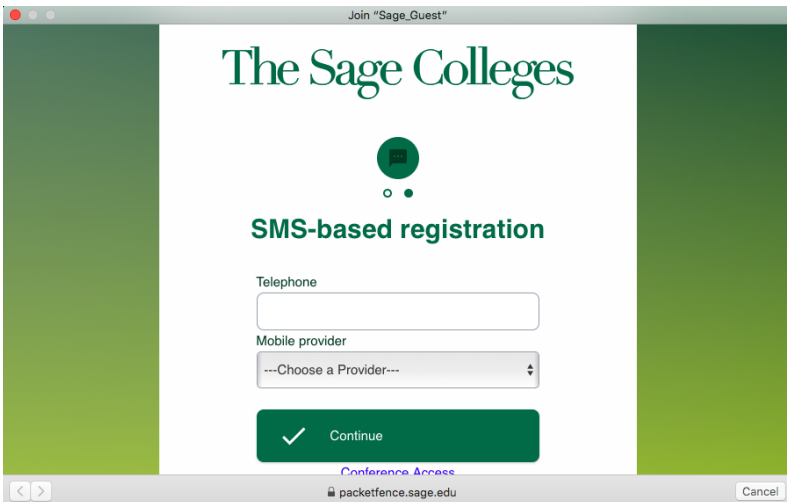
A new window will pop up on MacOS computers, for Windows computers you may need to open up a Web Browser (Chrome, Firefox, Explorer, Edge) for this page to display. **Check off the box that says accept the terms.**

## Provide your mobile number

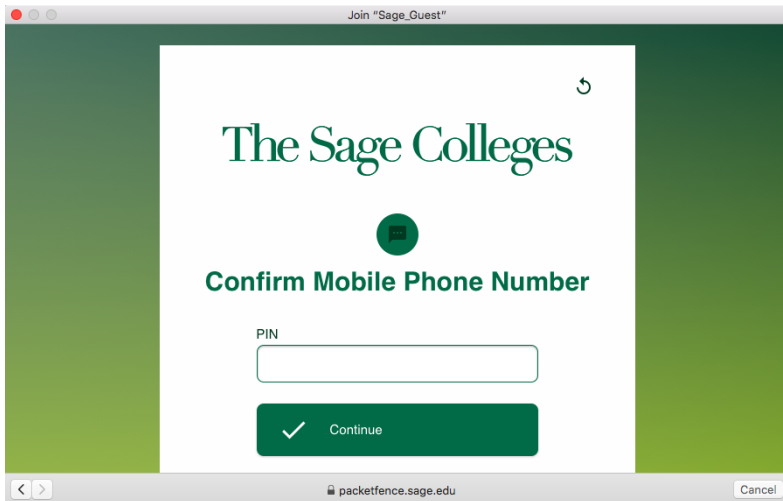
Enter in your cell phone number and choose your Cellphone Provider (Sprint, AT&T, Verizon, etc.) and click Continue.

## Verify your number

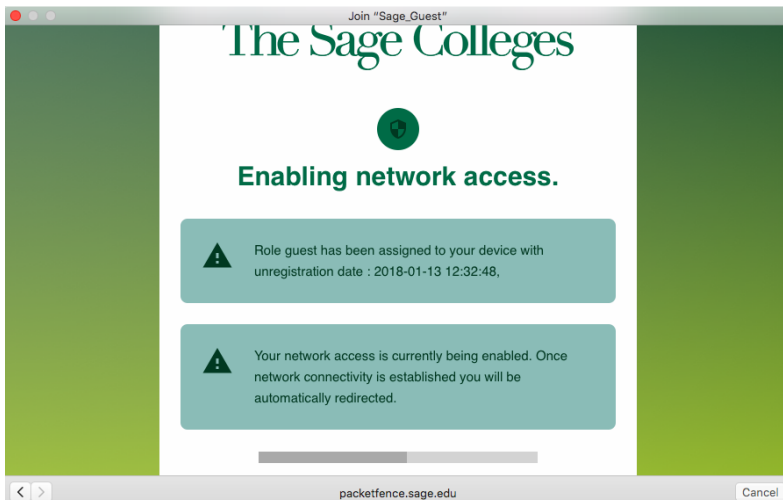
You will receive a text with a 6 digit pin number. On the following page enter the PIN number and click Continue.

## Get connected

If the PIN is correct the next page will load and inform you that your device has successfully connected to the Sage\_Guest Wifi.
